Apple seeks block in trade secrets case

Bengaluru: Apple on Monday asked a US judge for a preliminary injunction barring two former employees and OpenAI from accessing, acquiring, using or disclosing alleged confidential information as it moves ahead with its trade secrets case. Apple last month sued OpenAI and the two former employees, both now working for OpenAI, alleging misappropriation of its trade secrets to benefit ChatGPT.

‘US plans ban on Chinese data centre devices on security fears’

CURBING INCURSION. Move aims to prevent Chinese firms from stealing data

The Trump administration is drafting a ban on US imports of new models of Chinese data centre components, four people familiar with the matter told Reuters, as it seeks to protect the infrastructure that undergirds the US federal.

The Federal Communications Commission, which oversees the US telecom industry, is working on the measure to bar imports of new Chinese optical transceivers, which allow data to travel over fibre-optic cables at the speed of light within data centres.

DECISION PENDING Officials hope to publish it this year, when it would take effect.

The move, not previously reported, aims to prevent Chinese firms from stealing

data, installing malware or disrupting service at US data centres, which house the chips to train and run AI models. The FCC could still modify or shelve the restriction, the sources stressed, speaking on condition of anonymity to discuss sensitive matters. But it is the latest example of the Trump administration trying to limit Chinese technological incursions into cutting-edge US industries before they be-

come embedded in the supply chain. “Transceivers definitely pose a risk,” said Divyansh Kaushik, an AI policy expert at Washington DC advisory firm Beacon Global Strategies. “As the data centre build out scales up, you want to make sure their supply chain is secure from the get-go,” he added.

RESPOND IF NECESSARY The White House and the FCC did not respond to re-

quests for comment. The Chinese embassy in Washington said Beijing urges the US to “heed the objective and rational voices of the business communities in both countries” and “stop smearing Chinese companies and threatening them with sanctions.”

China hawks in the administration are keen to avoid another situation like Huawei, where telecom equipment made by the heavily sanctioned Chinese firm was so deeply embedded in US infrastructure that efforts to remove it were slow, expensive and incomplete.

A US ban on new models of Chinese data centre devices would likely hit China’s Zhongli Innolight, one of the biggest global sellers of transceivers, which was added to the Pentagon’s list of alleged Chinese military-backed companies in June. The list can be a harbinger of tougher action.

Twenty-five US states on Monday sued the Trump administration over its latest tariffs, alleging they were an attempt to replace import taxes that the Supreme Court struck down in February.

The US last month imposed double-digit tariffs on imports from 59 countries and the EU, saying they had failed to curb goods made with forced labour.

reversed decades of US policy favouring lower tariffs and free trade. Invoking the 1977 International Emergency Economic Powers Act (IEEPA), he imposed sweeping tariffs on imports from almost every country, citing the long-running US trade deficit as a national emergency.

After losing at the Supreme Court, the administration is once again trying to illegally raise taxes on families and businesses with a new round of tariffs,” New York Attorney General Letitia James said.

The administration has now turned to Section 301 of the Trade Act of 1974, which allows the President to impose tariffs and other sanctions against countries found to engage in unfair trade practices.

Trump had successfully used the provision during his first term to levy tariffs on China, and those measures withstood legal challenges.

Invoking Section 301, the administration imposed the new forced-labour tariffs of 10-12.5 per cent on countries accounting for 99 per cent of US imports.

White House spokesman Kush Desai said, “A foreign country’s failure to prohibit and effectively enforce a ban on imports produced with forced labour is unreasonable and burdens US commerce, including American workers, and must be addressed. Section 301 tariffs have proven to be a legally durable tool since the President’s first term, and they remain so now.”

India engaged with all stakeholders on Chabahar port operations, says MEA

India is in touch with all stakeholders and partners regarding operations at Iran’s strategically important Chabahar Port, even as the prolonged West Asia crisis and the expiry of the US sanctions waiver for the project have heightened uncertainty over its future.

Responding to a question on Chabahar during the weekly media briefing, MEA spokesperson Randhir Jaiswal said: “On Chabahar

operations, India is in contact with all stakeholders and associates regarding the matter.”

India’s Chabahar project is strategically important as

it provides access to Afghanistan and Central Asia, while bypassing Pakistan. India Ports Global Ltd., a government-owned company, operates the Shahid Beheshti terminal under a long-term agreement with Iran.

KEY HUB

The project is also a key component of India’s connectivity strategy through the International North-South Transport Corridor, aimed at improving trade links with Central Asia, Russia and Europe. The US had earlier

exempted Chabahar from certain sanctions on Iran, recognising its role in supporting Afghanistan’s economic development.

However, the waiver expired in April this year, effectively bringing fresh Iran project activity at the port to a halt pending further clarity.

Some officials had earlier expressed hopes that US economic sanctions on port activities could be rolled back once a lasting peace deal was reached between the US and Iran.

Crude oil slid as optimism grew that the US and Iran are moving closer to a deal to reopen the vital Strait of Hormuz.

Brent dropped more than 4 per cent below \$80 a barrel, reversing earlier gains. US Treasury Secretary Scott Bessent said in an interview with CNBC that there is a chance they may have a deal today or tomorrow to open the Strait.

Qatar, meanwhile, said a proposed de-escalation resolution was “being circulated between the parties.”

Both Qatar and Bessent cautioned there’s no solid agreement yet and Iran has not signalled there’s been progress on Hormuz.

LOOSE ENDS

Visible flows through the waterway, which carried about a fifth of the world’s crude before the war, have slowed as attacks on vessels and Iranian threats heightened safety concerns for shipowners and crews.

Oil prices have eased dramatically from last month’s peak, however, as President Donald Trump postponed new strikes on Iran to give talks more time.

The latest comments from Qatar on potential draft language for a deal appear to be part of a joint push to reopen Hormuz, while leaving the “even more difficult topics for later talks,” said Helge Andre Martinson, Senior Oil Analyst at DNB Bank ASA.

Meanwhile, oil giant Saudi Aramco said it is looking at options to expand its crude export capacity, including by potentially increasing the size of an east-west pipeline to the port of Yanbu, a Hormuz bypass that’s become a vital lifeline for Saudi Arabia during the war. The kingdom’s observed crude exports edged lower in July as

the war disrupted flows through Hormuz and Houthi rebels threatened shipments in the Red Sea.

Concise impedes flows from the region, global oil markets are “absolutely” in a supply deficit, Pacific Investment Management Co’s Greg Sharenov said in an interview with Bloomberg television on Tuesday.

Meanwhile, Ukraine’s shipping strikes across Russia’s oil supply chain increase the risk of further disruptions.

Large refineries, oil tankers, and major pipeline infrastructure were hit at least 30 times in July.

+ Hatsun Agro Product plans ₹1,000 crore capex in FY27 to enhance production

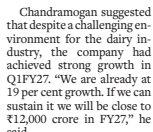

Hatsun Agro Product (HAP), India’s largest private sector dairy company has planned investments of around ₹1,000 crore in FY27.

In an interview, RG Chandramogan, Chairman, Hatsun Agro Product, suggested that the proceeds will be allocated towards expanding the company’s milk procurement and distribution network while also revamping some of its production facilities and marketing efforts.

He added that the investments made by Hatsun Agro’s plan to sell roughly 2.4 crore product packs per day within the next two years, up from the current 1.84 crore packs.

The Chennai-based firm posted revenues of ₹9,959 crore in FY26 — an increase of 14.5 per cent from the previous fiscal.

ded. The company has seen a 13 per cent year-on-year increase in milk prices, while procurement prices with Chandramogan attributing weather-related pressures, rising cattle feed costs and higher milk fat prices for the inflation.

“We delayed price hikes instead of immediately passing on higher procurement costs. We preferred waiting for the costs to sta-

bilise rather than implementing multiple successive price increases,” he said.

NEW PRODUCTS

Hatsun also plans to launch its range of protein-rich drinks within the next 1-2 months.

The founder added that detailed product information will be announced closer to launch, and did not disclose pricing or product specifications. Apart from protein beverages, Hatsun is also working on new ice-cream variants and chocolate products.

Hatsun Agro currently operates around 4,100 HAP Daily outlets as localised milk distribution networks for its dairy products sold under major brands including Aranya, Arun and Hatsun alongside 220 Baco outlets, its premium ice-cream brand. It plans to scale its store presence to over 5,000 by the financial year-end.

Progress made toward US-Iran talks, says Qatar

Qatar said mediators were making progress in efforts to end the US-Iran war on Tuesday, although Tehran has denied President Donald Trump’s assertion that talks are already underway.

Oil prices fell quickly after the comments from Qatar, extending Monday’s steep losses on hopes that an arrangement could soon be reached to unfreeze traffic through the blocked Strait of Hormuz. But for now, the Strait remained virtually shut, with another ship reportedly coming under attack while trying to cross.

Trump said on Monday that talks with Tehran had started and Iran faced a “last chance” to reach a deal. Iranian officials insisted no negotiations with the US were taking place. Iran said its only talks are with Oman about the Strait, and that no major meetings were



planned this week. “They are going on right now,” Trump told reporters at an Oval Office event on Monday when asked about negotiations, adding that discussions were taking place at the request of Iran, Saudi Arabia, the UAE and Qatar.

This is a last chance for them (Iran) to sign a good document.” Qatar’s foreign ministry spokesperson Majed Al-Ansari said diplomatic contacts had reached “very progressive stages.” Ansari said on Tuesday that mediators including Qatar, Pakistan and Oman were coordinating

closely to facilitate negotiations and exchange draft proposals between Washington and Tehran.

A senior Pakistani security official said: “A lot is happening in the background... We are talking to both sides. Our sole goal at this moment is to make both parties at least agree to start talking.”

Trump’s comments followed his weekend decision to cancel what he described as “massive attacks” on Iran, extending a pattern in which he has threatened major military action before later backing off and pointing to diplomatic contacts.

RISKS REMAIN

Iran has halted most traffic through the Strait of Hormuz, while Washington maintains a blockade of Iran-related shipping and ports, disrupting a corridor that normally carries about a fifth of global oil and liquefied natural gas shipments.

A cargo vessel reported being struck by an unidentified

projectile near the Strait of Hormuz off Oman’s coast, according to the UKMT maritime security agency.

Maritime sources told Reuters on Tuesday that the vessel was a dry bulk ship. Its crew had to abandon the vessel and one seafarer was missing.

Iran has long demanded control over the Strait, which it says it should share with Oman, which controls the opposite shore.

A senior Iranian source said Iran is seeking full control over inbound shipping through the Strait, and visibility over outbound traffic, with the ability to intervene if necessary.

Giving Iran such control would be a major shift in the regional balance of power in Tehran’s favour, and make it more difficult for the US administration to argue that “Operation Epic Fury”, which Trump launched alongside Israel in February, had weakened Washington’s longstanding foe.

Consider telecom manufacturing zone in M.P. extension of PLI, says Scindia

India’s first telecom manufacturing zone (TMZ) will serve as an extension of the current production-linked incentive, said Union Minister Jyotiraditya Scindia during the Telecom Manufacturing Zone Investors Meet in Mumbai.

The TMZ to be set up in Gwalior, Madhya Pradesh, is to attract ₹10,000-12,000 crore investment over two phases, focusing on 5G and 6G hardware, semiconductors, and optical fibre. Apart from being the first TMZ in the country, Scindia clarified that this will be the only such zone by the government.

“You can think of this TMZ as an extension of the PLI. There is close to ₹12,000 crore worth of in-

vestments in this TMZ. Investors will almost get ₹7,000-8,000 crore worth of incentives back. So in a way this is also a PLI,” said Scindia, when asked about sustaining PLI production volumes.

MAJOR PUSH PLI had led to almost ₹6,500 crore worth of investments, ₹1,20,000 crore worth of rev-

enue, ₹25,600 crore worth of exports and the creation of 35,000 jobs, according to Scindia.

Representatives of 20 telecom stakeholders, including Jio, Airtel and Vi, participated in the closed-door event.

“About 17 companies here, who have committed investments or committed to invest, they will be going to the drawing board. Many companies that have invested are saying that 80 per cent of their production will be done,” said Scindia, citing representatives from various verticals OEMs, telco, chip designers, bank investors, etc.

The commitments received will consider manufacturing, value addition and IP creation. Many companies spoke of wanting to set up their own testing labs and R&D labs.

ONGC consolidated net profit down at ₹6,554 cr

State-run ONGC on Tuesday reported a 43 per cent decline in its consolidated net profit at around ₹6,554 crore during Q1 FY27 as the net loss of ₹12,265 crore for Hindustan Petroleum Corporation was partially off-set by higher crude oil price realisation.

On a sequential basis, the country’s largest exploration and production (E&P) company’s net profit fell by a steeper 52 per cent.

However, ONGC on a standalone basis reported a net profit of ₹17,034 crore, more than double on an annual basis.

Consolidated total income was higher at around ₹2,08 lakh crore in Q1 FY27 compared to ₹1.77 lakh crore in Q4 FY26 and ₹1.66 lakh crore in Q1 FY26. ONGC’s consolidated total expenses were higher in the June quarter at roughly ₹2,02 lakh crore compared to ₹1.61 lakh crore in Q4 FY26 and ₹1.50 lakh crore in Q1 FY26.

“The ONGC Group’s consolidated Profit After Tax (PAT) for the quarter was significantly impacted by HPC’s consolidated net loss of ₹12,265 crore, primarily on account of under-recoveries on petroleum products arising from the sharp increase in crude oil prices following the West Asia crisis,” ONGC said in a statement.

However, the strong performance of other subsidiaries, including ONGC Videsh and MRPL, provided a positive contribution to the group’s overall financial performance, it added.

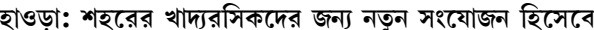
